
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

Training Details

Costs are per course (not per person) and we can accommodate as many learners as your venue will hold. We are just as happy working with small intimate groups or large conference style events. Get Playing – Play for Dads and Grandads

The Power of Play – The Therapeutic Benefits of Play

The course looks at the powerful therapeutic benefits of play and how we can use this knowledge to help children emotionally reset, build resilience and promote positive mental health. It shows how positive play can have the most profound effect on a child's emotional wellbeing and can help children to overcome emotional obstacles and develop confidence and self-esteem. The course also demonstrates how we can use play to help develop secure attachments with our children especially if those children are struggling emotionally. The course is intensely thought provoking, combining up to date neuroscience and biochemistry with therapeutic play techniques to create a unique toolkit for helping not just vulnerable children but all children. Learners will also take part in a wealth of practical activities designed to help children experience the therapeutic benefits of play and might just experience some of those benefits themselves. This course is specifically designed for adopters and fosterers but is also invaluable to anyone wanting to understand how Play can profoundly benefit our most vulnerable children.

Practical Attachment Theory

Understanding attachments is the fundamental key to unlocking children's emotional well-being and overall development. Developed and delivered by leading national specialists in working with vulnerable children this course helps us to directly support the children in our care to make those all-important secure attachments providing benefits that could last a lifetime.

This practical course looks at the latest theories of attachment and how we can directly apply these to support our children to make secure attachments. The course looks at the difficulties facing children with insecure attachments and how this may manifest in their behaviour and attitude. We also look at worrying trends in parenting such as increased screen time and decreasing face to face nurturing which are leading to more and more children with insecure attachments. The course also shows the stages a child with insecure attachments must go through to form positive bonds with an adult carer. This course is thought provoking, insightful and could have a profound impact on the children in our care. It is all very well knowing the theory but this course shows us what we can do with that theory to improve outcomes for our children. One secure relationship built with a firm understanding of attachment theory can be enough to reverse the effects of all of the other difficult attachments that may surround the child. All it takes is that one person and this is the purpose of the course – to help us to be that person.

Play into Sport – Getting Children Excited by Sport

Increasing physical activity levels, combating obesity and breaking cycles of inactivity are a challenge for any agency working with children especially Leisure Centres and Sports Coaches. Evidence suggests, however, that many children are reluctant to engage in sport. Using a play based approach to sports activities can have a profound impact on levels of engagement and inclusion and in recent studies has been shown to be the most successful approach in terms of long term benefits to children's health and physical activity levels. This course helps sports coaches and activity workers to include elements of play theory and a more process focused approach to better engage with children of all ability levels, even hard to reach children. It gives learners a basic understanding of play theory and its practical application and allows them to implement new techniques into sports sessions without compromising their sporting goals. Studies have shown that these techniques can raise levels of physical activity in all children including those already overweight or not predisposed towards sport.
